

**FAIRVIEW AREA SCHOOLS' BOARD OF EDUCATION
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
AUGUST 8, 2011**

A regular meeting of the Fairview Area Schools' Board of Education was held on Monday evening, August 8, 2011 in the elementary media center.

Board President Beth Miller called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

II. Approval of Agenda

The Agenda was approved by Board consensus.

A. Central Office Reorganization

The Building/Maintenance Committee met July 27, 2011 to discuss reorganizing the Central Office space. The committee recommends setting a work session in September to discuss actual floor plans for reconstruction and makes the following recommendations:

A. Central Office Reorganization, (Con't.)

Neff/Tompkins That personnel and equipment from the Superintendent's office, Finance office, Elementary and High School offices be moved to the existing central space to create a Central Office for the 2011-12 school year.

B. Snow Removal

So far no bids have been received for winter snow removal. It was suggested that snow removal, lawn maintenance, trimming, etc. could be bid out as a package.

VIII. NEW BUSINESS—ACTION ITEMS

A. Combined Classroom Teacher Approval

The District posted an internal job opening for a Second / Third Grade Teacher for the 2011-2012 school year with an August 5 deadline for submitting a letter of interest. The Superintendent makes the following recommendation:

Peterson/Tompkins That Kami Winton be hired as Second / Third Grade Teacher for the 2011-2012 school year.

B. 2011-2012 Budget Update

Mr. Ricketson presented information regarding changes to the 2011-2012 budget. Due to the federal government placing stricter regulations on allowable usage of federal funds, certain expenditures previously budgeted for Title I will be reassigned to the General Fund including some money designated for teacher salaries. This will open up new Title I funds that could be used to recall paraprofessionals.

C. Approval of New High School Elective Classes

Mr. Gusler submitted information concerning the addition of two new High School elective classes for the 2011-2012 school year. The Board is in favor of the classes but insists that any movies or media used for instructional purposes must follow policy.

Peterson/Danhoff That the Board approve "Mass Media" as an elective class for the 2011-2012 school year.

Peterson/Tappan That the Board approve "Advanced Performing Arts" as an elective class for the 2011-2012 school year.
